be taking care of your family member. They will be using many important medical "tools" for helping make people better.




This book will tell you about the things you may see or hear while you are visiting in the hospital.






The Family Center is a special place for families to check in before visiting other areas of the hospital. There is always someone working at this center who will help you find your family member's room.

handwashing





One of the best ways that you can help everyone in the hospital is to remember to wash your hands often before you go into your family member's room and when you leave. Being careful to be super-clean and not let germs into the hospital is very important!





The room where your family member is staying looks like this, with a special bed and other medical equipment. Some rooms have a lot of extra equipment to help people get better. People who are taking care of your family member will explain the things that you see and hear in the room.







A breathing machine, or ventilator, may be helping the person to breathe while his or her body is healing.



Some machines, like this monitor, are checking how different parts of a person's body are working.

Sometimes it makes beeping noises to tell the nurses important information.












People who work in the hospital wear special clothes called scrubs. They are very clean so no germs are spread in the hospital.
